



NOTICE OF REVIEW

POLLING DISTRICT AND POLLING PLACES

In accordance with Section 17 of the Electoral Administration Act 2013, North Norfolk District Council is required to conduct a review of polling districts and polling places within the North Norfolk parliamentary constituency and the part of the district which sits within the Broadland and Fakenham parliamentary constituency.

The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) is required to put forward representations to the Council, which must include information as to the location of the polling places, polling stations within each polling district.

Current arrangements and proposed amendments in respect of polling districts and polling places will be published by the ARO on **Monday 9th September 2024** and these will be available for inspection at the Council Offices and on the North Norfolk District Council website at www.north-norfolk.gov.uk

Representations can be made in writing to Electoral Services, Council Offices, Holt Road, Cromer, NR27 9EN or by email to electoralservices@north-norfolk.gov.uk. The deadline for representations is **Friday 11th October 2024** with all comments received by this date being considered ahead of the preparation of revised proposals by the ARO.

A further period of consultation will run on the revised ARO proposals between **Monday 21st October** and **Friday 8th November 2024**.

Final recommendations are due to be considered by Full Council in its meeting on **Wednesday 20th November 2024** and the outcome of the review will then be published.
