#### The Norfolk County Council (West Runton, A149 Cromer Road, C293 Station Road and U14274 Water Lane) (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2024

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2), 84 and 122 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Norfolk County Council (West Runton, A149 Cromer Road, C293 Station Road and U14274 Water Lane) (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 2024 and shall come into effect on the XX day of XX 2024.
- 2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the length of the roads specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour.
- 3. The Norfolk County Council (West Runton, Water Lane) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limit) Order 1999 is revoked on commencement of this Order and the length of the roads specified in the Schedule below are no longer restricted roads.
- 4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.

## In Parish of Runton

#### 20 mph Speed Limit

A149 Cromer Road	-	From a point 35 metres west of its junction with the 1P327 Church Lane to a point 50 metres east of junction with the 1P333 Roseberry Road
C293 Station Road	-	From its junction with A149 Cromer Road southwards for a distance of 120 metres
U14274 Water Lane	-	From its junction with the A149 Cromer Road for its entire length (a distance of 730 metres)
