Professional axe and knife throwing under tuition in small group sessions, including all equipment, run by Back to Wilderness.



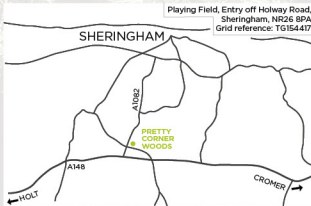
