## Project Overview

Balfour Beatty are delighted that works on the Cromer & Mundesley Coastal Management Schemes are progressing well. These essential works are being delivered by Coastal Partnership East on behalf of North Norfolk District Council and are being funded by the Environment Agency with NNDC and Mundesley Parish Council, contributing to Mundesley only. The Schemes will protect 600 local homes and businesses from flooding and coastal erosion.

Overview of project works are as follows:

### **Cromer Coastal Defence Scheme:**

These works involve the construction of a new rock armour revetment on the west side of Cromer pier, with 32,555 tonnes of rock placed on the shoreline. It will also include repair and installation of: concreting works, rock revetment and access improvement works.

### **Mundesley Coastal Defence Scheme:**

This will involve 20,863 tonnes of rock being placed on the shoreline to form a rock berm and a temporary rock stockpile. The team will also reinforce the existing coastal protection infrastructure. Work will see a rock revetment – used to absorb the energy from the waves - in front of the already existing steel frame structure (west beach), and in front of the Mundesley Volunteer Inshore Lifeboat Station.

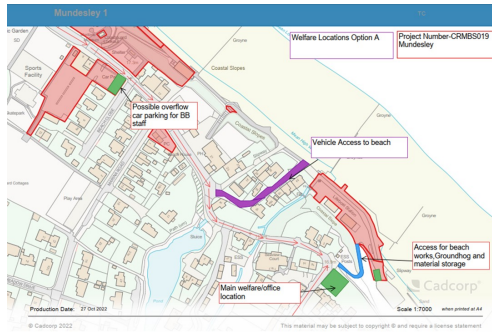

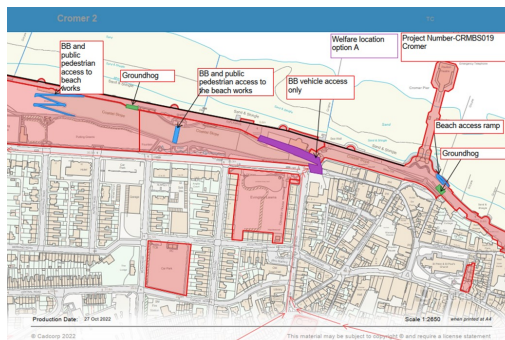


## Moving Forward
