What this Act does not cover

It is important to distinguish house-to-house collections from other types of activity:

Activity	Governing legislation
Street collections (public places)	Police, Factories etc. (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1916
Street trading (commercial sales)	Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982
House-to-house commercial selling	Separate consumer protection law (not the 1939 Act)

House to house charitable collections are governed by the **House to House Collections Act 1939** and the **House to House Collections Regulations 1947**, which require organisers to be licensed by the local authority unless a statutory exemption applies.

There is **no fee** for house-to-house collections or charitable collections.
