**REHABILITATION OF OFFENDERS ACT 1974**

<b>SENTENCE</b>	<b>BECOMES SPENT AFTER</b>
Absolute Discharge	6 months
Probation order in respect of persons convicted before 03/02/1995, supervision order conditional discharge or bind over	1 year from date of conviction or until order expires whichever is later
Probation order on or after 03/02/1995	5 years
Attendance centre order	1 year after expiry
Hospital order under Mental Health Act	5 years from date conviction or 2 years after order expires

<b>SENTENCE</b>	<b>BECOMES SPENT AFTER</b>
Imprisonment (including suspended sentence) of between 6 months and 2 ½ years (including cashiering, dismissal with disgrace, discharge with ignominy from Armed Forces)	10 years
Imprisonment (including suspended sentence) of up to 6 months (includes dismissal from Armed Forces and Borstal Training)	7 years
Fine or other sentence not otherwise covered in this table e.g. CSO Curfew	5 years
Detention under S53 Children & Young Persons Act between 6 and 30 months	5 years
Detention of less than 6 months under the above provisions	3 years

N.B. A sentence of more than 2 ½ years can never become spent.
