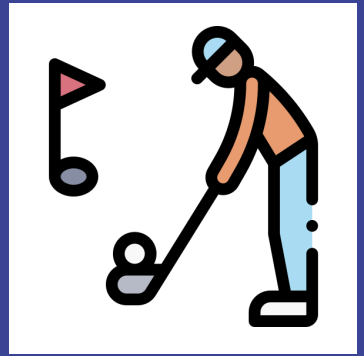

Visitor numbers are deliberately kept to moderate levels to ensure the playing experience is enjoyable for both members and visitors alike. This is a two ball course for singles and foursome play only.

The Wensum, Mattishall and Valley golf courses offer an array of challenges to golfers of all abilities. Situated just outside of Norwich, Wensum Valley's courses are playable all year round due to the free-draining soil and Norfolk being one of the UK's driest counties. Both 18 hole, par 72 courses present different challenges for golfers. The *Wensum* is the only golf course in Norfolk to host the PGA Eurotour and requires length off the tee and accuracy due to its well protected greens, whilst the *Valley* demands accuracy off the tee and skill on its undulating greens. Just a few minutes from Wensum Golf Club, Mattishall Golf Club offers a 9 hole course, excellent for beginners whilst the long, narrow greens will still prove challenging for the more experienced.

It is a terrific challenge for golfers of all abilities. with long par -fours and four cracking par-threes, but the par-fives offer the chance of gaining a stroke - as long as you are not too wayward. Visitors are welcomed and encouraged to take the chance to play a classic James Braid layout.

Members and visitors have access to a new 5 bay covered 230 yard range, which is backed by two driving nets. There is also an area for you to practise your short game, 120 yards to the green with multiple flag locations and targets and there is a Greenside/fairway bunker to practise your skills.
