



Public Sector Apprenticeship Target Data Publication for period 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022

The Public Sector Apprenticeship Targets Regulations 2017 updated by the Apprenticeships (Miscellaneous Provisions) regulations 2017 came into force on 31 March 2018. It is a requirement of the regulations that public sector bodies with 250 or more staff in England have a target to employ an average of at least 2.3 % of their staff as new apprentice starts over the period of 1 April 2017 to 31 March 2021.

Bodies in scope of the target are required to publish information annually showing progress towards the target.

A	The number of employees whose employment in England by the body began in the reporting period in question.	43
B	The number of apprentices who began to work for the body in that period and whose apprenticeships agreements began in that period. This includes employees who were already working for the body before beginning their apprenticeship, as well as new apprentices' hires.	2
C	The number of employees employed in England that the body has at the end of that period.	325
D	The number of apprentices who work for the body at the end of that period.	11
E	Figure B expressed as a percentage of figure A.	4.65%
F	Figure D expressed as a percentage of figure C.	3.38%
G	The number of apprentices who worked for the body immediately before that period.	18
H	Headcount on the day before the first day of each reporting period in the target period.	316
I	Figure B expressed as a percentage of figure H. This figure will enable the Government to assess the progress a body has made towards meeting the target.	0.63%
