

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, SOUTHREPPS)
(30 M.P.H. SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 1993

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h.
2. This Order comes into operation on the 1st day of March 1993, and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (Various Roads, Southrepps) (30 m.p.h. Speed Limits) Order 1993.

SCHEDULE

In the Parish of Southrepps

- C289 Thorpe Road/High Street/Chapel Street and Gimingham Road:- from a point 190 metres west of junction centre line with Gables Avenue to a point 320 metres east of junction centre line with Church Street, a distance of approximately 890 metres.
- C292 Long Lane:- from junction High Street south for a distance of 310 metres, including the two cul-de-sacs to the west.
- C292A Northrepps Road:- from junction Church Street west and north for a distance of 175 metres.
- C294 Church Street/Whitegate Road:- from junction with High Street northeast for a distance of 325 metres.

Sandy Lane:- between junctions Clipped Hedge Lane and Thorpe Road.
