Application for Discount G CARE WORKER

Qualifying Criteria

To be eligible for a voluntary care worker discount in respect of Council Tax, set out below is Paragraph 9 of Schedule 1 of the Local Government Finance Act 1992.

The following conditions must be met:

1. At any time in the day you are employed to provide care or support (or both) to another person(s) and –
2. You are employed by either:
 - (i) a local authority within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1972(a);
 - (ii) a person(s) to whom you are providing care or support under the employment, and you were introduced to that person by a body that has been established for charitable purposes only.
3. You are engaged or employed to do so for at least 24 hours a week. Your salary or wages with respect to the employment do not exceed £44.00 per week, and the day falls within a period during which the person is resident in premises which are provided by or on behalf of that employer for the better performance of your duties under the employment.
