

## Equipment – raised toilet seats and toilet aids

### 1. Raised toilet seat



- Larger front/rear cutouts provide easier access,
- Moulded plastic brackets keep it firmly in place,
- Easily adjusted to fit on most toilet shapes,
- Fitting and removal of the seat is quick,
- Comes in varying heights – 2, 4, or 6 inch.

### 2. Mowbray toilet frame



- Raised toilet seat with frame attached,
- Slots over the toilet,
- Grippable feet to prevent slipping or movement,
- Useful if there is no space to fit wall-fixed rails,
- Useful if there are plasterboard walls,
- Can be a potential trip hazard.

### 3. Toilet frame



- Can be used with raised toilet seat,
- Slots over the toilet,
- Grippable feet to prevent slipping or movement,
- Useful if there is no space to fit wall-fixed rails,
- Useful if there are plasterboard walls,
- Can be a potential trip hazard.

#### 4. Wall mounted rail



- Can be placed adjacent to toilet,
- Can be placed horizontal or vertical,
- Provides support to get up from toilet,
- Require a suitable wall for safe fixing.

#### 5. Drop down toilet support rail



- Can be placed to open side of toilet,
- Provides support to get up from toilet,
- Folds away - suitable in compact space,
- Require suitable wall for safe fixing.
